What is a personal ministry session?

A personal ministry session is a minimum 4 hour individual time to receive ministry in a more personal setting to deal with hindrances in your life that keep you from fully embracing and walking out your Kingdom purpose. Ministry sessions may also be received for married couples. The ministry session is designed for those individuals who are in continued pursuit of more freedom, healing, wholeness, and a lifestyle of peace, joy, and fulfillment. It is an opportunity to share your life in three stages – your life from when you were born to when you started school, school-age years and as an adult. Ninety percent of a person's strongholds (systems of thought based ib lies) are formed in the first 6-7 years of life. Questions will be asked to get the background information about your life before doing any deliverance and inner healing. Open doors that gave the enemy legal access in your life will be dealt with and ministered to thoroughly in the areas of willful sin, unforgiveness, inner vows and judgments, curses, and trauma. Fourteen times in the Bible it specifically says, "the spirit of..." The following root spirits will be evicted: infirmity, divination, fear, bondage, whoredom/idolatry, haughtiness, antichrist, deaf and dumbness, error, sleep and slumber, jealousy, and lying.

Who can receive personal ministry (prerequisite)?

Anyone between the age of 13 to adulthood who has attended a Freedom Ministry deliverance event (i.e., Journey to Wholeness, Freedom and Fullness Seminar, etc.) may receive a personal ministry appointment. Wisdom dictates that young people or children should be in agreement with receiving ministry and not simply being forced by parents. Only under extenuating circumstances (e.g., no scheduled events in 3-6 months, life-threatening emergencies, etc.) will this requirement be waived. If this requirement is waived OR if there are no deliverance ministry event scheduled within 3-6 months of your request, you will be required to listen to an audio on the process of deliverance and confirm your completion before the ministry session.

In addition, children under 13 years old may also receive personal ministry when certain conditions are met by the parent(s)/legal guardian: A) One or both parents (or legal guardian) must participate in a DWOC deliverance ministry event OR receive personal ministry session prior to child receiving personal ministry; B) Complete and submit an assessment form to provide some basic information about the child. If the child is at an appropriate age of accountability they must be willing to receive ministry and NOT be compelled to do so. The form must be returned preferably via email one week prior to the ministry appointment; and C) One parent must attend the personal ministry appointment with the child. Parental consent and agreement with the ministry process the child will receive is necessary for the protection and support of the child. We believe it is wisdom for the parent(s) to receive ministry for three reasons: 1) increases personal freedom in their own lives, 2) helps the ministry team to identify generational patterns in the child, and 3) allows the parent(s) to be made aware of and receive understanding of the ministry protocol their child will receive while equipping them with the basics to aid their child after receiving ministry.

How many personal ministry sessions can I receive?

Depending on the age and the nature of the circumstances experienced in life, most oftentimes it is necessary to have more than one ministry session. We believe that our life experiences can be similar to an onion peel with many layers and it is usually not possible to address everything in a 4-hour ministry session. You are encouraged to have as many ministry sessions as the Lord may lead you until you receive the freedom needed and able to be the person God originally intended. You will be advised by the ministry team if the need for additional ministry sessions is recommended.

Who can I expect to be in the ministry session?

The persons that will be assigned to conduct your ministry session have been trained on the importance of Christ-like character and a servant's heart as well as the skill and anointing

necessary to be vessels of honor in God's kingdom. There will be 2-3 people (Leader, Assistant, Intercessor) conducting the prayer ministry session.

What should I expect to happen in the ministry session?

Punctuality is extremely important and any late arrival times may be deducted from the allotted ministry time. During the ministry session, you will be interviewed in order to identify necessary areas of concentration for ministry. Ministry will be given in areas so that the person will experience the power and truth encounter with God that releases them from spiritual bondages. You are at liberty to ask questions during your prayer ministry time.

It is our aim to have the Holy Spirit lead us into areas of ministry that the Lord desires most to release to you during the ministry session. The prayer sessions are approached with the intent to be led by the Holy Spirit and we will do our best to listen to Him closely on how best to prophetically minister to your needs. We are not professional counselors, but servants of the Lord using our spiritual gifts to facilitate healing and deliverance in your life. This is **NOT** a counseling session, but prayer ministry. Please make plans to allow 4 hours for ministry.

How do I request a ministry appointment?

You may request an appointment two ways:

- 1. Visit the Freedom Ministry web site at **www.dwocfreedomministry.weebly.com**, Click '*Personal Ministry*' and complete the online request form.
- 2. Call KZC at 404/902-6410 and leave a message on the voice mail requesting a personal ministry session and give your name, contact numbers and email address. A ministry request form link will be emailed or mailed to you to complete and return.

Upon receipt of the ministry request form, you will be contacted by email and/or phone to coordinate and schedule your appointment within 5-10 days after our receipt.

How are ministry appointments scheduled?

Due to limited resources, ministry sessions are scheduled on a first come first served basis. Appointments are scheduled on the days below and are subject to change as needed.

Weekend: Fridays 5pm and Saturdays 1:00pm or 3:00pm

Under special circumstances, ministry sessions may be scheduled during weekdays (Wednesdays and Thursdays late mornings/afternoon)

Upon receipt of the ministry request form, you will be contacted by email to coordinate and schedule your appointment within 5-10 days after our receipt. Ministry appointments may be scheduled within 1-3 months from the date the ministry request form is received.

Is there a cost for the ministry session?

The sessions are provided on a love offering basis. We are a faith ministry and exist entirely on donations and free-will offerings. The laborer is worthy of his hire (Luke 10:7). Most prayer ministries with equivalent training suggest donations in the \$50 to \$90 per hour range. Please consider this as you pray concerning your donation. A recommended minimum amount for ages 13 to Adult is \$150 and children 12 and under \$75 for the 4 hour ministry session is appropriate and for any follow-up sessions. These funds will serve as honoraria for the person(s) who willfully sacrifice their time, gas monies, families, etc., to minister to your needs.
